

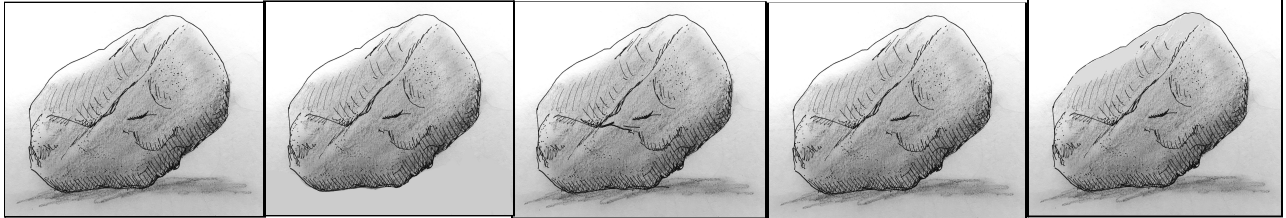


SERMON ACTIVITY PAGE

Dear friend, here's another activity sheet for you!

1. Look at the rocks below. Which two rock pictures are exactly the same? Hint: Check cracks, lines, light, and shadow.



2. Read the Bible scroll and the cartoon.

"HE WHO IS WITHOUT SIN AMONG YOU, LET HIM BE THE FIRST TO THROW A STONE AT HER."

1. Sometimes, when people use this Bible verse, they say, '**SEE??** You can't say I was wrong because YOU aren't perfect!'

2. But that's just **SILLY!** Of **COURSE** there's right and wrong... but we go to **GOD** for justice.

3. So since everyone had sinned, there was no one left to throw the first stone...

... OR WAS THERE????



4. **JESUS** is without sin, and had the right to pick up the first stone! ...So why didn't He?

5. Try to imagine this scene: The accusers are gone, but this woman still feels the weight of her guilt. What hope does she **HAVE** in the presence of a perfect God?

6. But then Jesus says, "**I DO NOT CONDEMN YOU!**" in the dark shadow of her sin and guilt shines the divine light of mercy and pardon. Jesus has forgiven her. What did she do to deserve such mercy? Nothing! Jesus Christ is so full of grace that He can forgive all our sins!

7. And we see at the very end, this is a grace that changes us. We don't keep sinning because we know we'll be forgiven anyway! Jesus' parting words to her were, "Go. From now on sin no more." Having been forgiven, live no longer in the darkness, but **WALK IN THE LIGHT!**

3. Think of one thing that makes you feel bad about yourself. If it's something you've done wrong, ask God's forgiveness first. Then, no matter what it is, ask God to help you see yourself through His eyes: Accepted and made by God and loved with an everlasting love. If you are not a Christian yet, you can ask Him to forgive you and make you His Child!
